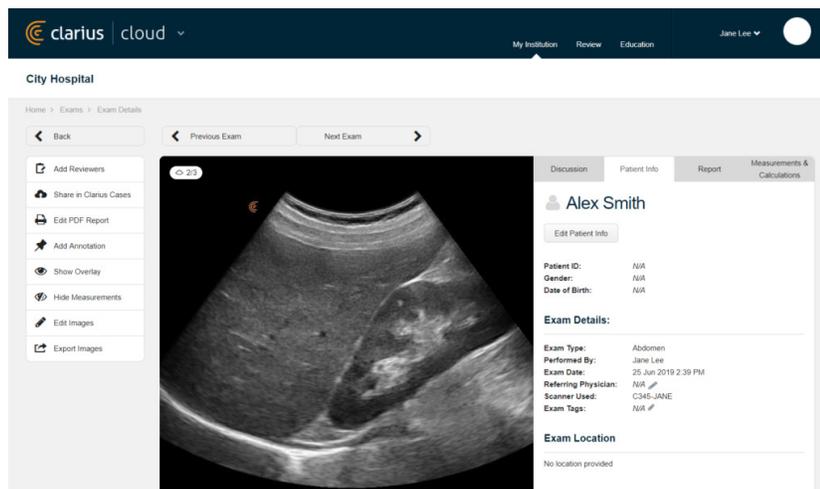

We've compiled a list of seven reasons why the Clarius Cloud may be an important benefit to consider when making a decision on which handheld ultrasound scanner is right for you.

1. Save all your ultrasound exams in a HIPAA-compliant portal.

While you're using Clarius, exam data and encrypted patient information are initially stored on your smart device where space can be limited. When you finish scanning, you then have the option to save to the Cloud. The ultrasound data is automatically uploaded using encrypted HTTPS when an internet connection is available.

Rest assured. The Clarius Cloud is designed with technical safeguards to ensure compliance with the regulations and conditions of the Health Insurance Portability and Availability Act of 1996 (HIPAA).



2. Access and manage your exams from anywhere.

We know that most clinicians are pressed for time when examining a patient. If you don't fill in all patient details while using the app, you can do it at your convenience when logged into the Clarius Cloud. Access your portal using a phone, tablet or computer from wherever you have an Internet connection. Click on Exams to access all the exams you captured and saved using your Clarius Scanner. You'll see a menu with tools and features, all of the images in your exam, patient information, measurements and calculations. You can add, edit, move and delete annotations and comments.

3. Generate detailed PDF reports for consultations and billing that impress colleagues.

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Clarius Cloud has a built-in, customizable PDF reporting tool. You can export any exam you've saved to the Cloud in a PDF, making it easy to print, archive and share professional reports for billing and consultations. Simply click "Print PDF Report" to create a report. You may choose which reviewer comments to include in the report. You can also choose to include any measurements and calculations or annotations in the report.

4. Collaborate and share, while keeping patient data secure.

You don't have to worry about patient confidentiality when sharing images and findings with others from the Clarius Cloud. Patient information is automatically redacted, enabling easy collaboration and consultation to enhance patient care.

To share an exam with a colleague who is a Clarius user and registered within your institution, simply enter their name and send the exam. To share outside your institution, you can type in an email address to send a link to view the exam.

6. Manage multiple scanners and users in an institutional account.

Whether you're an individual or part of an institution, your Clarius Cloud portal is where you manage who uses your scanner, as well as where you securely store and manage the ultrasound exams you and your colleagues capture with your Clarius scanner(s). Institution administrators have access to all data within the institution; clinicians only have access to their own patients' information and associated exams.

Administrators can easily activate and remove access to all scanners registered within an institution. And if a scanner goes missing, use the "Find your scanner" feature in the cloud.

7. Share cases publicly with your community for discussion with the Clarius Cases hub.
